Ann Wooler, widow Upper Town buried 11 May 1770.

Mrs. Jonathan Wooler at High Faunless of a son and heir October 1817.

Mrs. Wooler wife of George Wooler Esq. of Deckhams Hall of a son 8 July 1801, at Faunlees.
